# Topic/Science

Our topic for this half-term is 'Is there life in the universe?', which is based on the science objective 'Earth and Space'.

Children will learn what our Solar System is comprised of and will learn about the relative sizes of the planets. They will compare this to what the universe looks like and will begin to comprehend the vastness of the known and unknown.

Children will learn about the relationship between the Earth, Sun and Moon. They will learn how day and night occurs and will learn about the phases of the moon.

Children will also learn about astronauts and will find out what it takes to be an astronaut. They will also consider the possibility of space tourism and future space exploration.

Alongside this, children will complete several space themed pieces of art.

# Maths

For some maths lessons this half-term, Year 5 and 6 children will be split to support SATs preparation in Year 6. Year 5 children will be taught by Miss Bailey and Mrs Halmshaw.

Year 6 children this half-term will revise many of the areas taught so far this year as well as learning factors, multiples, square and cube numbers, algebra, pie charts and calculating the mean.

Year 5 children will learn factors, multiples, square and cube numbers and long multiplication. They will also revise areas they have found difficult such as rounding, area and perimeter, time and fractions, decimals and percentages.

# **English**

In English this half-term, the children will be focusing on writing to persuade and discuss. This will be based on the text Macbeth by Shakespeare. Children will spend some time getting to know the text and characters, performing drama and learning some Shakespearian quotations. Children will then write in the character of Lady Macbeth, persuading Macbeth that he should be king. Children will then discuss the questions 'Should Macbeth kill King Duncan?' and 'Who is responsible for King Duncan's death?'
